19-604. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN PART II OF THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) GROUP HOME.

"GROUP HOME" MEANS A COMMUNITY BASED FACILITY THAT:

(1) UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A RESIDENTIAL STAFF, PROVIDES A HOME FOR NONRETARDED DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED INDIVIDUALS WHO, BECAUSE OF THEIR DISABILITY, REQUIRE SPECIALIZED LIVING ARRANGEMENTS; AND

(2) ADMITS AT LEAST 4 BUT NOT MORE THAN 8 NONRETARDED DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED INDIVIDUALS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly appeared as Article 43, § 936(c).

The former reference to a "residential" facility is deleted as unnecessary in light of the reference to a "home" for individuals requiring "specialized living arrangements".

The only other changes are in style.

(C) NONRETARDED DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED INDIVIDUAL.

"NONRETARDED DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED INDIVIDUAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHOSE DISABILITY:

(1) IS ATTRIBUTABLE TO CEREBRAL PALSY, EPILEPSY, AUTISM, DYSLEXIA, OR ANY OTHER NEUROLOGICAL MALFUNCTION OR DISORDER;

(2) CAN BE EXPECTED TO CONTINUE INDEFINITELY;
