

SUBTITLE 7. HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS.

19-701. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) BENEFIT PACKAGE.

"BENEFIT PACKAGE" MEANS A SET OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO A MEMBER OF A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION UNDER A CONTRACT THAT ENTITLES THE MEMBER TO THE HEALTH CARE SERVICES, WHETHER THE SERVICES ARE PROVIDED:

(1) DIRECTLY BY A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION; OR

(2) THROUGH A CONTRACT OR ARRANGEMENT WITH ANOTHER PERSON.

(C) COMMISSIONER.

"COMMISSIONER" MEANS THE STATE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER.

(D) HEALTH CARE SERVICES.

(1) "HEALTH CARE SERVICES" MEANS SERVICES, MEDICAL EQUIPMENT, AND SUPPLIES THAT ARE PROVIDED BY A PROVIDER.

(2) "HEALTH CARE SERVICES" INCLUDES:

(I) AMBULANCE SERVICES;
