IF ANY PERSON VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF § 19-729 OF THIS SUBTITLE. THE COMMISSIONER MAY:

- (1) SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY TO DO BUSINESS AS A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION;
- (2) IMPOSE A PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 FOR EACH UNLAWFUL ACT COMMITTED;
- (3) ISSUE AN ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER THAT REQUIRES THE HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION TO:
- (I) CEASE INAPPROPRIATE CONDUCT OR PRACTICES BY IT OR ANY OF THE PERSONNEL EMPLOYED OR ASSOCIATED WITH IT;
