FOR the purpose of ~~providing--that--the--Board--of--Public

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 75A - Public Accountancy

~~-(e)~~ The Board shall charge each candidate a fee to be determined by the Board not in excess of ~~\$50.00~~ \$70 for his initial examination. A fee for reexamination or subsequent examination shall also be charged by the Board in an amount determined by it not in excess of ~~\$50.00~~ \$70 for each examination in all subjects, and in such smaller amount for each examination in less than all subjects as the Board may establish by regulation. The applicable fee shall in each case accompany the candidate's examination application.-}-
