- (1) [He was] WAS removed or involuntarily retired from judicial office pursuant to the Constitution or laws of this State;
- (2) [He voluntarily] VOLUNTARILY retired by reason of disability;
- (3) [His] HAD THE most recent service as a judge terminated by reason of [his] defeat for election to judicial office or by rejection of [his] confirmation by the Senate:
- (4) [He was] WAS censured by the Court of Appeals upon recommendation of the Commission on Judicial Disabilities; OR
- (5) [He is] IS engaged in the practice of law[; or
  - (6) He is 75 years old or older].
- (d) A former judge recalled under this section may not be temporarily assigned for more than [60] 90 working days in any calendar year. However if the case which the former judge is hearing at the end of the [60-] 90 day period is not concluded, the time may be extended until that case is concluded.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
