- (h) School board district VII consists of precincts 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 10, 11, 12, 15, 16, 17, and 18 of election district 6.
- (i) School board district VIII consists of precincts 8, 9, 13, and 14 of election district 6 and all of election district 12.
- (j) School board district IX consists of all of election districts 4, 5, 8, 9, and 11 and [precincts 2, 7, and 18] PRECINCT 2 of election district 6.
- (k) (1) Beginning in 1981, there shall be a redistricting every 10 years based on the latest U.S. census data.
- (2) The school board districts shall be divided into three groups:
- (i) Group I consists of school board districts I, IV, and VII;
- (ii) Group II consists of school board districts II, V, and VIII; and
- (iii) Group III consists of school board districts III, VI, and IX.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July June 1, 1982.

Elections - Absentee Ballots
