SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the annual expense allowance for the Sheriff of Allegany County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the annual expense allowance of the Sheriff of Allegany County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 6 - Caroline County

Where money to be expended by the County Commissioners of Caroline County for any materials, supplies, repairs, roads or capital improvements of any sort, except repairs to machinery or mechanical devices, exceeds the sum of one thousand dollars, the County Commissioners shall advertise
