

and rodent control and for the preparation and service of meals or food with alcoholic beverages.

(4) (i) Except as provided in paragraph (ii) below, in Prince George's County it shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to purchase alcoholic beverages, or to enter the premises of any holder of any alcoholic beverage license for the purpose of obtaining alcoholic beverages or to misrepresent his age for the purpose of obtaining alcoholic beverages, or to have alcoholic beverages on or about his person. It shall also be unlawful for any person to misrepresent the age of a person under the age of twenty-one (21) years for the purpose of obtaining alcoholic beverages for such person, or for any person to obtain alcoholic beverages for the use of a person under the age of twenty-one (21) years.

(ii) In Prince George's County, it is lawful for any person 19 years old or older to purchase beer and light wine, or to enter the premises of any holder of an alcoholic beverage license for the purpose of obtaining beer or light wine, or to have beer or light wine on or about his person.

(d-1) In Garrett County, in addition to any other provisions of this article, the license of any person may be suspended for a period of time to be determined by the board, such period not to exceed one (1) year, for any of the following grounds: (1) sale of alcoholic beverages to a person under eighteen (18) years of age and under twenty-one (21) for alcoholic beverages other than beer or light wines; (2) possession on the licensed premises by any person of any liquor or wines not purchased from the Garrett County liquor dispensaries, if the Garrett County liquor control board maintains county liquor dispensaries; (3) sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday. The decision of the board in such cases shall be conclusive.

(e) (1) In Harford County the liquor control board and general manager shall make or have frequent inspections made of the premises of all licensees. If it is found that any such licensee is violating any of the provisions of this article, or the regulations promulgated hereunder UNDER IT, or is failing to observe in good faith the purposes thereof OF IT, or is not maintaining the premises in a clean, sanitary manner, the board shall, in its discretion, after a public hearing, MAY revoke or suspend the license and these cases shall be reported to the State's Attorney and the Sheriff of Harford County. The Sheriff and the State's Attorney shall prosecute such THE licensee under the provisions of this article. The board shall also MAY revoke or suspend, in their discretion, and after public hearing the license of any licensee, on whose
