

(2) [Any minor having such alcoholic beverages in his possession as aforesaid shall upon conviction be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than fifty dollars nor more than two hundred dollars or imprisoned in jail for not less than thirty days or more than ninety days, or be both fined and imprisoned in the discretion of the courts.] ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF VIOLATING PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON CONVICTION SHALL BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$200 OR IMPRISONED FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS, OR BOTH FINED AND IMPRISONED IN THE DISCRETION OF THE COURT.

(e) In Wicomico County:

(1) [A person under 18 years may not possess or have upon his person any alcoholic beverages.] A PERSON UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE MAY NOT POSSESS OR HAVE UPON HIS PERSON ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES EXCEPT THAT A PERSON DESIGNATED UNDER § 2(T)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE MAY POSSESS OR HAVE UPON HIS PERSON BEER OR LIGHT WINE OF 14 PERCENT OF ALCOHOL BY VOLUME.

(2) [Except a bona fide employee in the course of his employment, a person under 21 years may only possess or have upon his person beer or light wine of 14 percent of alcohol by volume.] THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DO NOT APPLY TO A BONA FIDE EMPLOYEE IN THE COURSE OF HIS EMPLOYMENT.

(3) Any person violating this subsection upon conviction is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$50.

(f) (1) In Somerset, Caroline, Dorchester, Cecil, Frederick, Washington, Garrett, and Queen Anne's counties, it [shall be] IS unlawful for any person under the age of [twenty-one] 21 years to possess or have [upon] ON his person any alcoholic beverages other than beer and light wine, [and] for any person [under eighteen years] NOT DESIGNATED IN § 2(T)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE to possess or have [upon] ON his person any alcoholic beverage, except a bona fide employee in the course of his employment. [Any minor having such alcoholic beverages in his possession as aforesaid shall upon conviction be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00).] In Somerset County, a person [under 21 years] DESIGNATED IN § 2(T)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE may only possess or have [upon] ON his person beer or light wine of 14 percent alcohol by volume.

(2) ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND SHALL BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$50.
