- (b) (1) The provisions of this subsection apply to Harford County.
- (2) It is unlawful for any person [under 18 years of age] NOT DESIGNATED UNDER § 2(T)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE to:
- (i) Purchase or attempt to purchase any alcoholic beverages; or
- (ii) Drink or have in his or her possession any alcoholic beverage.
- (3) It is unlawful for any person -{-under 21 years of age-}--NOT--DESIGNATED--UNDER--\$--2(T)(2)--OF--THIS ARTICLE to:
- (i) Purchase or attempt to purchase any alcoholic beverage, except beer or light wine; or
- (ii) Drink or have in his or her possession any alcoholic beverage, except beer or light wine.
- (4) The provisions of this subsection do not apply to bona fide employees in the course of their employment whose employment is not prohibited by this article.
- (5) Any person violating the provisions of this subsection is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined an amount not exceeding \$50 for each violation.
- (A) It is unlawful for any person under 21 years of age in Prince George's County to have in his possession or to consume any alcoholic beverages, except beer and light wine, in any public place or on any public highway, and it is unlawful for any person [under 18 years of age] NOT DESIGNATED IN § 2(T)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE to have in his possession or to consume any beer or light wine in any public place or on any public highway. The provisions of this section do not apply to bona fide employees in the course of their employment and whose employment is not prohibited by this article.
- (B) Any person violating the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction [thereof,] shall be [subject to a fine of] FINED not [less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor] more than [one hundred dollars (\$100.00)] \$100 for each violation.
