defined in Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland other than beer and light wine, and, for any person [under eighteen years] NOT DESIGNATED UNDER ARTICLE 2B, § 2(T)(2) OF THE CODE to have beer or light wine, unless [such] THE person shall then and there be a bona fide employee of a license holder, as defined in [the said] Article 2B, and shall then and there have in his possession, or under his charge or control, [such] alcoholic [beverage] BEVERAGES during regular working hours and in the course of his [or her] employment.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

Driver's License or Privilege - Revocation and Reinstatement

FOR-the-purpose-of-altering-the-times-at-which-an-individual may--apply--for--reinstatement--of--a--revoked-driver-s license--or--privilege; --under--certain--sircumstances; repealing--certain--language-relating-to-when-the-Motor Vehicle-Administration-may-reinstate-a-revoked-driver-s license-or-privilege; -and-slarifying-language.

FOR the purpose of altering certain time provisions regarding when the Motor Vehicle Administration may reinstate a revoked driver's license or privilege; altering certain time provisions regarding when an individual may apply for reinstatement of a revoked driver's license or privilege, under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the reinstatement of a revoked driver's license or privilege.
