

(B) (1) -- EACH MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE.

(2) -- EACH MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED FROM A CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THAT DISTRICT.

(3) -- THERE SHALL BE 2 MEMBERS FROM EACH OF THE 8 CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS OF THIS STATE.

(C) (1) -- THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER IS 4 YEARS.

(2) -- THE TERMS OF THE APPOINTED MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL ON JULY 1, 1982. -- THE TERMS OF THOSE MEMBERS END AS FOLLOWS:

(i) -- 1 IN 1983,

(ii) -- 4 IN 1984,

(iii) -- 4 IN 1985, AND

(iv) -- 5 IN 1986.

(3) -- AT THE END OF A TERM, AN APPOINTED MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) -- A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(5) -- A MEMBER WHO SERVES 2 CONSECUTIVE FULL 4 YEARS MAY NOT BE REAPPOINTED FOR 4 YEARS AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THOSE TERMS.

EVERY 4 YEARS, FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRMAN WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE SECRETARY.

19-106-

(A) -- EACH MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL IS ENTITLED TO:

(1) -- COMPENSATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, AND

(2) -- REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(B) -- THE COUNCIL MAY EMPLOY A STAFF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
