

(21) § 21-902(b) ("Driving while under the influence of alcohol");

(22) § 21-902(c) ("Driving while under influence of drugs or drugs and alcohol"); or

(23) § 21-902(d) ("Driving while under influence of controlled dangerous substance").

SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That chapter(s) of the Acts of the General Assembly read(s) as follows:

Chapter 135 of the Acts of 1981

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section [20(h)] 21(H) shall apply with respect to weeks of unemployment beginning after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections [20(i)] 21(I), (j) and (k) shall apply with respect to weeks of unemployment beginning after March 31, 1981.

SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act are intended solely to correct technical errors in the law and that there is no intent to revive or otherwise affect law that is the subject of other Acts, whether those Acts were signed by the Governor prior to or after the signing of this Act.

SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

(Senate Bill 193)

AN ACT concerning

Special Education - Continuation
of Day Care Placements
