Unencumbered funds as of June 30, 1983, shall revert to general fund revenue. The Commission shall use a portion of the special funds made available herein for the purposes of making grants to health systems agencies which have been designated as health planning agencies in accordance with Section 19-111(a) for fiscal year 1983.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 2-106(a)(12) through 2-106(a)(40) and 19-121, respectively, of Article - Health - General (as enacted by Chapter (H.B. 200 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1982) be renumbered to be Section(s) 2-106(a)(11) through 2-106(a)(39) and 19-125, respectively.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1982.
