(c) Unless otherwise provided by law, the unimpaired capital and surplus of a commercial bank include its debt instruments issued under § 3-312 of this title.

SECTION-2.--AND-BE-IT-FURTHER-ENACTED; That-this-Act-is hereby-declared-to-be-an-emergency-measure-and-necessary-for the-immediate-preservation-of-the-public-health-and-safety and-having-been-passed-by-a-yea-and-nay-vote-supported-by three-fifths-of-all-the-members-elected-to-each-of--the-two Houses--of-the-General-Assembly; the-same-shall-take-effect from-the-date-of-its-passage:

CHAPTER 110

(Senate Bill 16)

AN ACT concerning

Alcoholic Beverages - Dorchester County

FOR the purpose of providing that in Dorchester County, upon the death of certain alcoholic beverages licensees, a new license may be issued to certain survivors of the deceased licensee without the necessity of any further proceedings for the balance of the current license year; and providing that in Dorchester County a renewal alcoholic beverages license may be issued to the certain survivors of the deceased licensee if they qualify to hold a license under the provisions of Article 2B of the Annotated Code.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 78(b) Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1981 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:
