CHAPTER 110

(Senate Bill 16)

AN ACT concerning

Alcoholic Beverages - Dorchester County

FOR the purpose of providing that in Dorchester County, upon the death of certain alcoholic beverages licensees, a new license may be issued to certain survivors of the deceased licensee without the necessity of any further proceedings for the balance of the current license year; and providing that in Dorchester County a renewal alcoholic beverages license may be issued to the certain survivors of the deceased licensee if they qualify to hold a license under the provisions of Article 2B of the Annotated Code.
