(b) Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in this article, upon the death of any married licensee, or upon the death of any licensee holding that license for the benefit of a partnership or corporation, upon application to the official issuing the license, a new license shall be issued to the surviving spouse, the surviving partners for the benefit of the partnership, or the senior surviving officer for the benefit of the corporation without the necessity of any further proceedings for the balance of the current license year. A renewal license may be issued to the surviving spouse or to the surviving members of a partnership or corporation, if they qualify to hold license under the provisions of this article. The provisions of this subsection apply only in the following subdivisions:

- (1) Anne Arundel County
- (2) Baltimore County
- (3) Baltimore City
- (4) Charles County
- (5) DORCHESTER COUNTY
- [(5)] (6) Prince George's County

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
