Pursuant to the authority conferred on me by Article III Section 52, Sub-section (5) of the Constitution of Maryland, and in accordance with the consent of the (State Senate) - (House of Delegates), duly granted, I hereby submit a supplement to Senate Bill 380 and/or House Bill 620 in the form of an amendment to the original budget and additional proposal for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1983.
