(b) The Administration and the Division jointly may establish standards by rule or regulation for this equipment.

(Senate Bill 419)

AN ACT concerning

Human Relations Commission - Judicial Review

FOR the purpose of creating a right of appeal from a no probable cause finding by the Human Relations Commission under certain circumstances.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 49B - Human Relations Commission

- (a) After the filing of any complaint the executive director shall consider the complaint and shall refer it to the Commission's staff for prompt investigation and ascertainment of the facts. The results of the investigation shall be made as written findings. A copy of the findings shall be furnished to the complainant and to the person, firm, association, partnership or corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "respondent"), against whom or which the complaint is made.
- (b) If the finding is that there is probable cause for believing a discriminatory act has been or is being committed within the scope of any of these subtitles, the Commission's staff immediately shall endeavor to eliminate
