- (7) (A) THE FUND SHALL HAVE THE STAFF AND EMPLOYEES WHICH ARE AUTHORIZED IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET.
- (B) THE FUND ANNUALLY SHALL SUBMIT ITS BUDGET TO THE GOVERNOR FOR INCLUSION IN THE NEXT STATE BUDGET SUBMITTED TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
 - (8) (A) THERE IS A SUBSEQUENT INJURY FUND BOARD.
- (B) (I) THE BOARD IS COMPOSED OF 3 MEMBERS, 1 MEMBER EACH SHALL REPRESENT LABOR, MANAGEMENT, AND THE PUBLIC.
- (II) THE MEMBERS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.
- (III) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS SHALL BE FOR 4 YEARS.
- (IV) VACANCIES SHALL BE FILLED BY THE GOVERNOR IN THE SAME MANNER AS ORIGINAL APPOINTMENTS ARE MADE.
- (C) THE BOARD SHALL SUPERVISE THE OPERATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE SUBSEQUENT INJURY FUND.
- (D) THE BOARD SHALL APPOINT-AN-ADMINISTRATOR A DIRECTOR FOR THE FUND WHO SHALL RECEIVE THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET.
- (E) THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL RECEIVE TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET:
- (I) A PER DIEM COMPENSATION FOR EACH DAY AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD; AND
- (II) REIMBURSEMENT FOR ACTUAL AND INCIDENTAL EXPENSES OF TRAVEL REQUIRED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.
- (F) THE BOARD SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1. THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE A STATEMENT IN DETAIL OF THE EXPENSES AND BALANCES OF THE FUND.

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- (a) There is created a Workmen's Compensation Fund Board hereinafter referred to as the "Board."
- (b) The Board is composed of 3 members, each to be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate and to serve for a term of four years. One member
