EMPLOYEE-EMPLOYER RELATIONSHIPS, AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 64A, § 15A(A)(3) OF THE CODE; or

(ii) Medicaid, judicare, or similar reimbursement contracts for which user eligibility and cost are set by law or by rules and regulations.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1982.

## CHAPTER 173

(House Bill 514)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - Board of Examining Engineers

FOR the purpose of continuing the existence of the Board of Examining Engineers in accordance with the Regulatory Programs Evaluation Act of 1978 (Sunset Law) by extending to a certain date the termination provisions for the Board.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

The Public Local Laws of Baltimore City Section 4-7 Article 4 - Public Local Laws of Maryland (1979 Edition, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 4 - Baltimore City

4-7.

The provisions of this subtitle creating the Board of Examining Engineers and relating to the regulation of Engineers and any regulations promulgated under this subtitle are of no effect and may not be enforced after July 1, [1983] 1989 1993.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
