- (C) "COMMITTEE" MEANS THE CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEES ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SUBHEADING.
- (D) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

- (A) THERE IS A CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT LOCATED IN EACH--OF--THE FOLLOWING-REGIONS:

- (B) EACH COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF 7 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION.
- (C) (1) THE SENATOR AND EACH DELEGATE FROM THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN WHICH THE REGION-IS INSTITUTIONS ARE LOCATED SHALL EACH SUBMIT A NAME TO THE GOVERNOR.
- (2) EACH MEMBER NOMINATED BY A SENATOR OR DELEGATE SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AND OF THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN WHICH THE REGION-IS INSTITUTIONS ARE LOCATED.
- (3) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT EACH PERSON NOMINATED BY A SENATOR OR DELEGATE FOR A VACANCY ON A COMMITTEE WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF THE NOMINEE'S NAME.
- (D) (1) TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, THE ADDITIONAL 3 MEMBERS SHALL BE APPOINTED TO PROVIDE FOR LEGAL, LAW ENFORCEMENT, AND BUSINESS REPRESENTATIVES ON EACH COMMITTEE.
