204E-1.

(A) IN THIS SUBHEADING THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) "COMMISSIONER" MEANS THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

(C) "COMMITTEE" MEANS THE CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEES ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SUBHEADING.

(D) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

204E-2.

(A) THERE IS A CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT LOCATED IN EACH--OF--THE FOLLOWING-REGIONS:

(1) BALTIMORE;

(2) HAGERSTOWN; AND

(3) JESSUP,--AND

(4)--OTHER---REGIONS---AS---DESIGNATED---BY---THE COMMISSIONER.

(B) EACH COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF 7 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION.

(C) (1) THE SENATOR AND EACH DELEGATE FROM THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN WHICH THE REGION-IS INSTITUTIONS ARE LOCATED SHALL EACH SUBMIT A NAME TO THE GOVERNOR.

(2) EACH MEMBER NOMINATED BY A SENATOR OR DELEGATE SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AND OF THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN WHICH THE REGION-IS INSTITUTIONS ARE LOCATED.

(3) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT EACH PERSON NOMINATED BY A SENATOR OR DELEGATE FOR A VACANCY ON A COMMITTEE WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF THE NOMINEE'S NAME.

(D) (1) TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, THE ADDITIONAL 3 MEMBERS SHALL BE APPOINTED TO PROVIDE FOR LEGAL, LAW ENFORCEMENT, AND BUSINESS REPRESENTATIVES ON EACH COMMITTEE.
