- (3) (1) REPORT TO THE COMMISSIONER AND THE GOVERNOR ABOUT THE CONCERNS OF THE CITIZENS RESIDING IN THE VICINITY OF EACH INSTITUTION IN-THE-REGION;
- (4) (2) BE AVAILABLE TO INTERPRET EACH INSTITUTION'S PROGRAMS AND PROBLEMS TO THE CITIZENS RESIDING IN THE VICINITY OF EACH INSTITUTION IN-THE-REGION; AND
- (5) (3) PERFORM OTHER SERVICES AND RESPONSIBILITIES DESIGNATED-BY-THE-COMMISSIONER AS MAY BE DEEMED NECESSARY.
- (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE STAFF TO THE COMMITTEE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That of the members of each Citizens' Advisory Committee established under this Act, 3 shall be appointed for 3 year terms, 2 shall be appointed for 2 year terms, and 2 shall be appointed for 1 year terms. Thereafter, each member of a Committee shall be appointed to 3 year terms as provided by this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
