

Article - Health Occupations

20-206.

(A) (1) THE BOARD MAY SET REASONABLE FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATES AND ITS OTHER SERVICES.

(2) THE FEES CHARGED MAY BE SET SO AS TO PRODUCE FUNDS TO APPROXIMATE THE COST OF MAINTAINING THE BOARD.

(B) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, THE BOARD MAY PAY EXPENSES INCURRED IN CARRYING OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.

(C) THE BOARD SHALL PAY ALL FUNDS COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THIS STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 202

(House Bill 991)

AN ACT concerning

Queen Anne's County - State's Attorney

FOR the purpose of providing that the salary of the State's Attorney of Queen Anne's County shall be set by the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County; altering the salary of the State's Attorney of Queen Anne's County; and providing that this Act does not affect the incumbent.
