SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

8-106.

(b) A juror shall receive the per diem amount stated in this section for each day he attends court as a juror in:

(17) Prince George's County--

(I) [\$10] \$15 expense money plus an additional \$5 expense money if [his] THE JUROR'S service extends past 6:00 p.m. and a second additional \$5 if [his] THE JUROR'S service extends past 9:00 p.m. on any day[.];

(II) AN ADDITIONAL \$5 IF A GRAND JUROR PROVIDES THE JURY COMMISSIONER AN AFFIDAVIT EVIDENCING INCOME LOST AS A DIRECT RESULT OF GRAND JURY DUTIES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 216

(House Bill 1210)

AN ACT concerning

Queen Anne's County - State's Attorneys

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State's Attorney of Queen Anne's County to appoint additional assistant State's attorneys with the approval of the County Commissioners; and providing that the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County shall set the salary of the assistant State's attorneys.
