(b) A juror shall receive the per diem amount stated

(17) Prince George's County--

- in this section for each day he attends court as a juror in:
- (I) [\$10] \$15 expense money plus an additional \$5 expense money if [his] THE JUROR'S service extends past 6:00 p.m. and a second additional \$5 if [his] THE JUROR'S service extends past 9:00 p.m. on any day[.];
- (II) AN ADDITIONAL \$5 IF A GRAND JUROR PROVIDES THE JURY COMMISSIONER AN AFFIDAVIT EVIDENCING INCOME LOST AS A DIRECT RESULT OF GRAND JURY DUTIES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

## CHAPTER 216

(House Bill 1210)

AN ACT concerning

Queen Anne's County - State's Attorneys
