(II) ALL SIGNS ERECTED OR REPLACED AFTER JULY 1, 1982 WHICH RESERVE A SPACE FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS SHALL BE IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.

(2) (i) Except as provided in this paragraph, the bottom edge of the sign shall be at least [8] 7 feet above the ground.

(ii) If the sign is placed against a building, structure, or other location that does not obstruct vehicle or pedestrian traffic, the bottom edge of the sign shall be at least 6 feet AND NO MORE THAN 10 FEET above the ground.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
