- (II) ALL SIGNS ERECTED OR REPLACED AFTER JULY 1, 1982 WHICH RESERVE A SPACE FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS SHALL BE IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.
- (2) (i) Except as provided in this paragraph, the bottom edge of the sign shall be at least [8] 7 feet above the ground.
- (ii) If the sign is placed against a building, structure, or other location that does not obstruct vehicle or pedestrian traffic, the bottom edge of the sign shall be at least 6 feet AND NO MORE THAN 10 FEET above the ground.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
