CHAPTER 236

(House Bill 1877)

AN ACT concerning

Caroline County - County Commissioners

FOR the purpose of altering the salaries of the President and members of the Caroline County Board of County Commissioners; providing that each commissioner shall receive reimbursement for expenses incurred in the performance of official duties; and providing that the salary alteration shall not affect the incumbent commissioners.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 6 - Caroline County

12.

[The County Commissioners of Caroline County shall each receive an annual salary of \$8,000, and all necessary expenses as provided by the State standard travel regulations.] THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IS \$9,500. THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE OTHER MEMBERS IS \$9,000. EACH COUNTY COMMISSIONER SHALL RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF OFFICIAL DUTIES AS PROVIDED BY STATE STANDARD TRAVEL REGULATIONS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary of the Caroline County Commissioners in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary of the Caroline County Commissioners shall take
