- ASSOCIATION DISAPPROVES A REQUEST OR DOES NOT TAKE ACTION WITHIN 45 DAYS OF THE REQUEST, THEN THE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OR RESCUE SQUAD REQUESTING ASSISTANCE MAY APPEAL TO A PANEL COMPRISED OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE MARYLAND STATE
