- 3-301. OFFICES ESTABLISHED; SCOPE OF SECTION.
 - (A) IN GENERAL.

THERE IS A HEALTH OFFICER FOR EACH COUNTY.

(B) SCOPE OF SECTION.

SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT PREVENT AN INDIVIDUAL FROM SERVING AS A HEALTH OFFICER FOR MORE THAN 1 COUNTY.

- 3-302. APPOINTMENT; QUALIFICATIONS; OATH; REMOVAL.
 - (A) IN GENERAL.

THE HEALTH OFFICER FOR A COUNTY SHALL BE NOMINATED BY THE COUNTY AND APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY.

(B) NOMINATION PROCEDURES.

THE GOVERNING BODY OF EACH COUNTY SHALL ESTABLISH, BY ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION, THE PROCESS BY WHICH THE COUNTY NOMINATES AN INDIVIDUAL FOR HEALTH OFFICER.

- (C) APPOINTMENT OR REJECTION OF NOMINEE.
- (1) IF THE SECRETARY FINDS THAT A NOMINEE MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE SECRETARY SHALL APPOINT THE NOMINEE AS HEALTH OFFICER.
- (2) IF THE SECRETARY FINDS THAT THE NOMINEE DOES NOT MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE SECRETARY SHALL REJECT THE NOMINATION, AND THE COUNTY SHALL PROVIDE THE SECRETARY WITH ANOTHER NOMINATION.
