

The former reference to "components" is deleted as included in the language "any part".

The former parenthetical exception for certain sections is deleted as unnecessary in light of the substitution of "symbol" for "device" in those sections.

(G) DRUG.

(1) "DRUG" MEANS ANY SUBSTANCE OR COMPONENT OF A SUBSTANCE:

(I) THAT IS RECOGNIZED IN AN OFFICIAL COMPENDIUM;

(II) THAT IS INTENDED FOR USE IN THE DIAGNOSIS, CURE, MITIGATION, TREATMENT, OR PREVENTION OF DISEASE IN HUMAN BEINGS; OR

(III) EXCEPT FOR FOOD, THAT IS INTENDED TO AFFECT THE STRUCTURE OR ANY FUNCTION OF THE HUMAN BODY.

(2) "DRUG" DOES NOT INCLUDE A DEVICE.

(H) FEDERAL ACT.

"FEDERAL ACT" MEANS THE FEDERAL FOOD, DRUG, AND COSMETIC ACT AS THAT ACT APPEARS AT 21 U.S.C. § 301 ET SEQ.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Article 43, § 187A(w).

The former phrase "as amended from time to time" is deleted as unnecessary in light of Article 1, § 21 of the Code.

(I) FOOD.

"FOOD" MEANS, EXCEPT IN SUBTITLE 6 OF THIS TITLE:

(1) ANY SUBSTANCE THAT IS USED AS FOOD OR DRINK FOR HUMAN BEINGS OR AS A COMPONENT OF FOOD OR DRINK FOR HUMAN BEINGS; OR

(2) CHEWING GUM OR ANY SUBSTANCE THAT IS USED AS A COMPONENT OF CHEWING GUM.
