SUBTITLE 1. CONFIDENTIAL RESEARCH RECORDS.

4-101. "CONFIDENTIAL RECORD" DEFINED.

IN THIS SUBTITLE, "CONFIDENTIAL RECORD" MEANS ANY RECORD, REPORT, STATEMENT, NOTE, OR OTHER INFORMATION THAT:

- (1) IS ASSEMBLED OR OBTAINED FOR RESEARCH OR STUDY BY:
 - (I) THE DRUG ABUSE ADMINISTRATION;
 - (II) THE JUVENILE SERVICES ADMINISTRATION;

OR

- (III) THE SECRETARY; AND
- (2) NAMES OR OTHERWISE IDENTIFIES ANY PERSON.
- REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language that combines, without substantive change, the first and second clauses each of former Articles 43, § 1-I(a), 43B, § 22(a), and 52A, § 8(b). It is rephrased as a definition for brevity.
