

THE MOTHER BUT-AFTER-A-GESTATION-PERIOD-OF-20-WEEKS-OR-MORE, REGARDLESS OF THE DURATION OF THE PREGNANCY, AS INDICATED BY THE FACT THAT, AFTER THE EXPULSION OR EXTRACTION, THE FETUS DOES NOT BREATHE OR SHOW ANY OTHER EVIDENCE OF LIFE, SUCH AS HEART BEAT, PULSATION OF THE UMBILICAL CORD, OR DEFINITE MOVEMENT OF VOLUNTARY MUSCLE.

(F) FILE.

"FILE" MEANS TO PRESENT FOR REGISTRATION ANY CERTIFICATE, REPORT, OR OTHER RECORD OF BIRTH, DEATH, FETAL DEATH, ADOPTION, MARRIAGE, OR DIVORCE FOR WHICH THIS SUBTITLE PROVIDES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly appeared as Article 43, § 14(a)(2).

The former reference to registration "by the State Board of Health and Mental Hygiene" is deleted as obsolete with respect to the Board and unnecessary in light of the use of the defined term "registration".

(G) FINAL DISPOSITION.

"FINAL DISPOSITION" MEANS THE BURIAL, CREMATION, OR OTHER FINAL DISPOSITION OF A BODY OR FETUS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly appeared as Article 43, § 14(a)(7).

The former word "interment" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the synonym "burial".

The only other changes are in style.

(H) INSTITUTION.

"INSTITUTION" MEANS ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ESTABLISHMENT:

(1) TO WHICH INDIVIDUALS ARE COMMITTED BY LAW;
OR
