

IF THE APPLICANT AND THE SOFT DRINK FOR WHICH THE APPLICANT SEEKS REGISTRATION MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

- (1) REGISTER THE SOFT DRINK; AND
- (2) ISSUE A REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE TO THE APPLICANT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language added to express the formerly only implied duty of the Department to register a soft drink that meets the requirements of this subtitle and to issue a registration certificate to a qualified applicant.

4-319. SCOPE OF REGISTRATION.

WHILE IT IS EFFECTIVE, A REGISTRATION AUTHORIZES THE SALE IN THIS STATE OF THE SOFT DRINKS IDENTIFIED IN THE REGISTRATION.

PART IV. TERM, RENEWAL, SUSPENSION, AND REVOCATION OF LICENSES AND REGISTRATIONS.

4-322. TERM AND RENEWAL OF LICENSE AND REGISTRATION.

(A) TERM OF LICENSE AND REGISTRATION.

A LICENSE OR REGISTRATION EXPIRES ON THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF ITS EFFECTIVE DATE UNLESS THE LICENSE OR REGISTRATION IS RENEWED FOR A 1-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) RENEWAL NOTICE.

AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE THE LICENSE OR REGISTRATION EXPIRES, THE SECRETARY SHALL SEND TO THE LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT STATES:

- (1) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT LICENSE OR REGISTRATION EXPIRES;
- (2) THE DATE BY WHICH THE RENEWAL APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SECRETARY FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE
