ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE LICENSE OR REGISTRATION EXPIRES; AND

- (3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.
- (C) APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL.

BEFORE THE LICENSE OR REGISTRATION EXPIRES, THE LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW IT FOR AN ADDITIONAL 1-YEAR TERM, IF THE LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT:

- (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED OR REGISTERED:
- (2) PAYS TO THE SECRETARY A RENEWAL FEE EQUAL TO THE APPLICATION FEE OR INSPECTION FEE REQUIRED FOR AN ORIGINAL LICENSE OR REGISTRATION; AND
- (3) SUBMITS TO THE SECRETARY A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE SECRETARY REQUIRES.
  - (D) ISSUANCE OF RENEWAL.

THE SECRETARY SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE OR REGISTRATION OF EACH LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

- 4-323. SUSPENSIONS AND REVOCATIONS -- GROUNDS.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 4-324 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE DEPARTMENT MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE OR REGISTRATION IF THE LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT:

- (1) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY OBTAINS A LICENSE OR REGISTRATION;
- (2) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY USES A LICENSE OR REGISTRATION; OR
  - (3) VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE.
  - (B) DURATION OF SUSPENSION.
  - A SUSPENSION UNDER THIS SECTION LASTS UNTIL THE
