

ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE LICENSE OR REGISTRATION EXPIRES; AND

(3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.

(C) APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL.

BEFORE THE LICENSE OR REGISTRATION EXPIRES, THE LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW IT FOR AN ADDITIONAL 1-YEAR TERM, IF THE LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT:

(1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED OR REGISTERED;

(2) PAYS TO THE SECRETARY A RENEWAL FEE EQUAL TO THE APPLICATION FEE OR INSPECTION FEE REQUIRED FOR AN ORIGINAL LICENSE OR REGISTRATION; AND

(3) SUBMITS TO THE SECRETARY A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE SECRETARY REQUIRES.

(D) ISSUANCE OF RENEWAL.

THE SECRETARY SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE OR REGISTRATION OF EACH LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

#### 4-323. SUSPENSIONS AND REVOCATIONS -- GROUNDS.

(A) GROUNDS.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 4-324 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE DEPARTMENT MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE OR REGISTRATION IF THE LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT:

(1) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY OBTAINS A LICENSE OR REGISTRATION;

(2) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY USES A LICENSE OR REGISTRATION; OR

(3) VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) DURATION OF SUSPENSION.

A SUSPENSION UNDER THIS SECTION LASTS UNTIL THE
