

MAY CLEAN THE CONTAINER BY WASHING IT BY MACHINE WITH WATER THAT:

(I) IS AT LEAST 125 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT IN THE WASH CYCLE;

(II) CONTAINS A CLEANSING MIXTURE EQUIVALENT TO A CAUSTIC SODA SOLUTION OF AT LEAST 2.5 PERCENT IN THE WASH CYCLE; AND

(III) IS PURE AND CLEAN IN THE RINSE CYCLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Article 43, § 164(e).

In subsection (a) of this section, the former references to "bottles", "jugs", and "barrels" are deleted as included in "container".

In subsection (b) of this section, the former word "foul" is deleted as included in "unsanitary".

In subsection (c) of this section, the former phrase "potable and of good sanitary quality" is deleted as included in "pure and clean".

4-333. CLOTHING OF PERSONNEL IN MANUFACTURING PLANT.

EACH INDIVIDUAL WHO WORKS IN A MANUFACTURING PLANT SHALL WEAR CLEAN CLOTHING WHEN THE INDIVIDUAL IS WORKING IN THE MANUFACTURING PLANT.

4-334. PROHIBITED ACTS.

(A) MANUFACTURING WITHOUT LICENSE.

A PERSON MAY NOT MANUFACTURE A SOFT DRINK IN THIS STATE FOR SALE IN THIS STATE UNLESS LICENSED BY THE SECRETARY.

(B) SALE OF UNREGISTERED SOFT DRINKS.

IN THIS STATE, A PERSON MAY NOT SELL A SOFT DRINK MANUFACTURED OUTSIDE OF THIS STATE UNLESS THE SOFT DRINK HAS BEEN REGISTERED WITH THE DEPARTMENT.

(C) EMPLOYMENT IN MANUFACTURING PLANT OF INDIVIDUAL WITH CERTAIN DISEASES.
