publishes the Grade A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance.

(I) MILK.

"MILK" MEANS THE MILK OF A COW OR GOAT.

"MILK FAT" MEANS THE NATURAL FAT OF MILK.

- (1) "MILK PLANT" MEANS ANY PLACE WHERE, FOR DISTRIBUTION, MILK PRODUCTS ARE:

 - (II) PASTEURIZED;
 - (III) BOTTLED OR PACKAGED; OR
 - (IV) PREPARED.
- (2) "MILK PLANT" DOES NOT INCLUDE A PLACE WHERE MILK PRODUCTS ARE SOLD AT RETAIL ONLY.

The former terms "collected", "handled", and "stored" are omitted in this subsection to reflect the apparent legislative intent that the Secretary is required to issue a milk plant permit only for a place where an activity enumerated in this revised subsection occurs.
