(B) TYPES OF PERMITS.

A PERMIT IS REQUIRED TO:

- (1) BE A BOBTAILER;
- (2) BE A CERTIFIED INDUSTRY DAIRY FARM INSPECTOR;
  - (3) BE A MILK PROCESSOR;
  - (4) BE A MILK PRODUCER;
  - (5) BE A MILK TRUCK TANK OPERATOR;
  - (6) OPERATE A DISTRIBUTION STATION;
  - (7) OPERATE A RECEIVING STATION; OR
  - (8) OPERATE A TRANSFER STATION.
  - (C) EXCEPTIONS.

A PERMIT IS NOT REQUIRED FOR:

- (1) A MILK PRODUCER WHO IS CUTSIDE THIS-STATE THE DEPARTMENTAL INSPECTION AREA IF THE RAW MILK FROM THAT MILK PRODUCER IS PROCESSED BY A MILK PROCESSOR WHO HOLDS A PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE;
- (2) A MILK TRUCK TANK OPERATOR WHO IS--NOT--IN THIS-STATE-IF-THE-RAW-MILK-THAT-THE-MILK-TRUCK-TANK-OPERATOR HANDLES--IS-PROCESSED-BY-A-MILK-PROCESSOR-WHO-HOLDS-A-PERMIT ISSUED-UNDER-THIS-SUBTITLE RECEIVES RAW MILK FROM OUTSIDE THE DEPARTMENTAL INSPECTION AREA; OR
- (3) A GROCERY STORE, RESTAURANT, SODA FOUNTAIN, OR SIMILAR ESTABLISHMENT WHERE MILK PRODUCTS ARE SERVED OR SOLD AT RETAIL IF:
- (1) THE ESTABLISHMENT COMPLIES WITH ALL APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE AND ALL APPLICABLE RULES OR REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND
  - (II) THE MILK PRODUCT IS RECEIVED FROM:

1---A--MILK--PROCESSOR-THAT-IS-ITSELF

EXEMPT; -OR

2---A- FROM A PERMIT HOLDER.
