4-412. APPLICATIONS FOR PERMITS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

AN APPLICANT FOR A PERMIT SHALL:

- (1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE SECRETARY ON THE FORM THAT THE SECRETARY PROVIDES; AND
- (2) PAY TO THE SECRETARY THE ANNUAL FEE SPECIFIED IN THIS SECTION.
 - (B) FEE SCHEDULE.

THE SECRETARY SHALL CHARGE THE FOLLOWING FEES FOR PERMITS:

- (1) BOBTAILER PERMIT\$50.

 (2) CERTIFIED INDUSTRY DAIRY FARM INSPECTOR \$10.

 (3) DISTRIBUTION STATION PERMIT\$25.

 (4) MILK PROCESSOR PERMIT\$100.

 (5) MILK PRODUCER PERMITNO FEE.

 (6) MILK TRUCK TANK OPERATOR PERMIT\$5.

 (7) RECEIVING STATION PERMIT\$25.
