SUBTITLE 5. COLD STORAGE.

PART I. DEFINITIONS; GENERAL PROVISIONS.

4-501. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) COLD STORAGE.

"COLD STORAGE" MEANS STORING, PLACING, OR KEEPING IN A COLD STORAGE WAREHOUSE AT A TEMPERATURE THAT DOES NOT EXCEED 45 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from the first clause of former Article 43, § 230.

(C) FOOD.

"FOOD" MEANS ANY FOOD THAT IS LISTED IN § 4-502 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to avoid repetition of phrases such as "butter, eggs, fish, fresh meat, fresh meat products, game, or poultry".

(D) COLD STORAGE WAREHOUSE.

"COLD STORAGE WAREHOUSE" MEANS AN ARTIFICIALLY COOLED PLACE IN WHICH FOOD IS PLACED IN COLD STORAGE FOR 30 DAYS OR MORE.
