(B) CONTENTS.

THE SECRETARY SHALL INCLUDE A SERIAL NUMBER ON EACH LICENSE ISSUED.

4-711. SCOPE OF LICENSE.

WHILE IT IS EFFECTIVE, A LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO OPERATE THE CRAB MEAT PLANT IDENTIFIED ON THE LICENSE.

4-712. TERM, RENEWAL, AND NONTRANSFERABILITY OF LICENSES.

(A) TERM OF LICENSE.

A LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE LAST DAY OF FEBRUARY AFTER ITS EFFECTIVE DATE, UNLESS THE LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 1-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) RENEWAL NOTICE.

AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES, THE SECRETARY SHALL SEND TO THE LICENSEE, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT STATES:

(1) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT LICENSE EXPIRES;

(2) THE DATE BY WHICH THE RENEWAL APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SECRETARY FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES; AND

(3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.

(C) APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWAL.

BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES, THE LICENSEE PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW IT FOR AN ADDITIONAL 1-YEAR TERM, IF THE LICENSEE:

(1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED;

(2) PAYS TO THE SECRETARY A RENEWAL FEE OF \$10;
