4-810. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE.

THE SECRETARY SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

4-811. SCOPE OF LICENSE.

WHILE IT IS EFFECTIVE, A LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO MANUFACTURE FROZEN DESSERTS AND FROZEN DESSERT MIXES AT THE MANUFACTURING PLANT IDENTIFIED IN THE LICENSE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the references to the scope of a license in the first sentence of former Article 43, § 193(c), the third sentence and the last half of the first sentence of (d) and the first clause of (g).

4-812. TERM, RENEWAL, AND NONTRANSFERABILITY OF LICENSES.

(A) TERM OF LICENSE.

A LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF ITS EFFECTIVE DATE, UNLESS THE LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 1-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) RENEWAL NOTICE.

AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES, THE SECRETARY SHALL SEND TO THE LICENSEE, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT STATES:

(1) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT LICENSE EXPIRES;

(2) THE DATE BY WHICH THE RENEWAL APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SECRETARY FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES; AND

(3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.
