PART II. SHELLFISH.

4-1005. IMPORTING SHELLFISH PROHIBITED.

EXCEPT FOR SHELLSTOCK THAT IS IMPORTED INTO THIS STATE FOR REPLANTING UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE TIDEWATER ADMINISTRATION, A PERSON MAY NOT IMPORT SHELLFISH INTO THIS STATE UNLESS THE SHELLFISH IS FROM A SOURCE CERTIFIED BY THE U. S. PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE FOR INTERSTATE SHIPMENT.

The term "Tidewater Administration" is substituted for the reference to the "Department of Tidewater Fisheries" in light of Ch. 601, Acts of 1979.

4-1006. IMPORTING FOOD CONTAINING SHELLFISH PROHIBITED.

(A) PROHIBITION.

UNLESS THE SHELLFISH CONTAINED IN THE FOOD COMES FROM A SOURCE CERTIFIED BY THE U. S. PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE FOR INTERSTATE SHIPMENT, A PERSON MAY NOT IMPORT INTO THIS STATE ANY FOOD THAT CONTAINS SHELLFISH.

(B) DUTIES OF FOOD PROCESSORS.

EACH PROCESSOR OF A FOOD THAT CONTAINS SHELLFISH THAT IS IMPORTED INTO THIS STATE SHALL:

(1) KEEP ON FILE PROOF THAT THE SHELLFISH IS FROM A SOURCE CERTIFIED BY THE U. S. PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE FOR INTERSTATE SHIPMENT; AND

(2) PROVIDE THIS PROOF TO THE DEPARTMENT ON REQUEST.

4-1007. POWERS OF DEPARTMENT.

THE DEPARTMENT MAY:
