"WAREHOUSEMAN" MEANS A PERSON WHO:

- (1) STORES BARBITURATES FOR OTHERS; AND
- (2) HAS NO CONTROL OVER THE DISPOSITION OF THOSE BARBITURATES EXCEPT FOR THE PURPOSE OF THAT STORAGE.

(J) WHOLESALER.

"WHOLESALER" MEANS A PERSON WHO IS ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF DISTRIBUTING BARBITURATES TO PERSONS IN ANY CLASS LISTED IN § 4-1105(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
