(D) FAILURE TO KEEP RECORDS.

A PERSON MAY NOT FAIL TO KEEP RECORDS AS REQUIRED BY § 4-1106 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(E) REFUSING TO MAKE RECORDS AVAILABLE.

A PERSON MAY NOT REFUSE TO GIVE THE DEPARTMENT FULL OPPORTUNITY TO CHECK ANY RECORD OR FILE, AS REQUIRED BY § 4-1106(E) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(F) TRADE SECRETS.

A PERSON MAY NOT USE TO PERSONAL ADVANTAGE OR REVEAL, EXCEPT TO THE DEPARTMENT OR TO A COURT IN A JUDICIAL PROCEEDING UNDER PART II OF THIS SUBTITLE, ANY INFORMATION THAT:

(1) IS OBTAINED UNDER AUTHORITY OF § 4-1106(E) OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(2) CONCERNS METHODS OR PROCESSES THAT ARE ENTITLED TO PROTECTION AS TRADE SECRETS.
