

COMMODITY FROM THE APPLICATION OF THIS SECTION IF THE SECRETARY FINDS THAT THE COMMODITY MAY BE DISPENSED BY VENDING MACHINE OR OTHER SIMILAR DEVICES WITHOUT DANGER TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section formerly appeared as Article 43, § 272(a) and (b).

In subsection (b) of this section, the former word "vend" is deleted as included in "sell".

Also in subsection (b) of this section, the former reference to an "automatically operated coin machine" is deleted as included in "vending machine or other similar device".

In subsection (c) of this section, the former references to permits are deleted as obsolete.

The only other changes are in style.

4-1112. MEDICINE OR PATENT MEDICINE SHOWS.

(A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY:

- (1) SURGICAL OR DENTAL INSTRUMENT;
- (2) PHYSICAL THERAPY EQUIPMENT;
- (3) X-RAY APPARATUS; OR
- (4) COMPONENT PART OR ACCESSORY OF ANY OF THESE ITEMS.

(B) PROHIBITED ACTS.

A PERSON MAY NOT:

(1) SELL, DISTRIBUTE, OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF ANY DRUG, MEDICINE, PHARMACEUTICAL PREPARATION, OR MEDICINAL PREPARATION BY MEANS OF ANY PUBLIC EXHIBITION, ENTERTAINMENT, PERFORMANCE, OR CARNIVAL, COMMONLY KNOWN AS A "MEDICINE SHOW" OR "PATENT MEDICINE SHOW"; OR

(2) PUT OR CAUSE TO BE PUT, IN ANY WAY, ANY PACKAGE, PARCEL, OR SAMPLE OF ANY DRUG OR MEDICINE:

(I) IN OR ON ANY PART OF ANY HOUSE, BUILDING, OR YARD WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER OR OCCUPANT; OR

(II) ON ANY STREET OR PUBLIC HIGHWAY.
