INSERTED IN THE POISON REGISTER INSTEAD OF THE ENTRIES OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

(D) FORM; RETENTION; INSPECTION.

A POISON REGISTER SHALL BE:

- (1) IN THE FORM REQUIRED BY THE BOARD;
- (2) KEPT FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS AFTER THE LAST ENTRY; AND
 - (3) OPEN TO INSPECTION BY ANY PROPER AUTHORITY.
 - (E) SIGN REQUIRED.

ANY PERSON WHO IS REQUIRED TO KEEP A POISON REGISTER SHALL DISPLAY CONSPICUOUSLY IN EACH STORE IN WHICH THE PERSON SELLS CONTROLLED POISON A SIGN THAT:

- (1) IS AT LEAST 9 INCHES IN HEIGHT AND 12 INCHES IN WIDTH; AND
- (2) STATES: "UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS STATE, ALL PURCHASERS OF POISONS MUST SIGN THE RECORD OF PURCHASE".

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Article 43, § 276(a), (c), and (d) and the last clause of § 279.

In the introductory clause of subsection (b) of this section, the phrase "or otherwise provides" is substituted for "disposes of" and "furnishes" and the former phrase "at retail", which modified "sells", is deleted as unnecessary.

In subsection (b)(1) of this section, the phrase "or delivery" is new language added for clarity.

In subsection (b)(2) of this section, "person for whom the controlled poison is provided" is substituted for "purchaser" to state the presumed intent of the legislature.

In the introductory clause of subsection (e) of this section, the reference to a "person who is required to keep a poison register" is substituted for the phrase "every store where poisons are sold".
